Måns Nilsson is Executive Director at the Stockholm Environment Institute (SEI) and is Professor of Practice at the Royal Institute of Technology (KTH).

Key research interests include policy coherence, institutions and governance, transitions in energy-industry-transport sectors, and innovation policy. In recent years, he has been closely involved in the development and implementation of the 2030 Agenda at different levels, as an advisor to the UN, OECD, the European Commission and the Government of Sweden.

Måns has slipped over 60 papers past unsuspecting editors of academic journals and has edited two books. He received his MSc in International Economics from University of Lund, Sweden, and his PhD degree in Policy Analysis from Delft University of Technology, Netherlands. He is a member of the Royal Swedish Academy of Agriculture and Forestry, and serves on the Board of Directors of Blekinge Tekniska Högskola (BTH) and IVL Svenska Miljöinstitutet AB.
