Her fight against energy-intensive systems led her to work for the ADEME (French Agency for the Environment and Energy Management) in the search for sustainable energy solutions for residential buildings. Prior to that, Yamina worked as a building expert in the Environment and Energy Efficiency Department at the International Energy Agency (IEA) where she created and directed the Sustainable Buildings Centre (SBC). The center assesses the impact of implementing energy efficiency policies for buildings in terms of energy savings, CO2 emissions reductions, implementation costs and economic benefits at the country and end-user levels.
