Roberto Schaeffer is Professor of Energy Economics at the Energy Planning Program of the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.

He holds a PhD in Energy Management and Policy from the University of Pennsylvania and his research interests include integrated assessment modeling of energy, land-use, and climate change mitigation.

He has contributed to the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) in various roles over the past 25 years and was a co-recipient of the 2007 Nobel Peace Prize for his research contribution to the IPCC. He has been Associate Editor of the international journal “Energy” since 1998, and an elected member of the Brazilian Academy of Sciences since 2021.

He is also a member of the Vulnerability, Impacts, Adaptation and Climate Services Advisory Board of the World Climate Research Programme and a member of the Climate and Clean Air Coalition’s international Advisory Group.

Dr. Schaeffer was recipient of the 2020 Integrated Assessment Modelling Consortium (IAMC) “Award for Extraordinary Contribution to the Field of IAM”, and recipient of the 2022 Brazilian Centre of Foreign Relations (CEBRI) “Academic Award”.
