Speranta Dumitru is an Associate Professor of Political Science at Paris Cité University, specialized in migration and mobility.

After obtaining a Ph.D. in Political studies with the highest honors from the EHESS (School of Advanced Studies in Social Sciences, Paris), she worked as a postdoctoral researcher in several European universities and research centers (CNRS, Louvain-la-Neuve, Paris-Diderot, Institut Télécom).

At the Paris Cité University, she held the Chair of Excellence in Political Science and Social Ethics (2009-2014), and since 2015, she has been director of a Master's in Management program, with a specialization in Ethics and ESG. She teaches Economic and Social Ethics, Development Ethics, Ethics and International Trade and related disciplines.

In her research, Speranta Dumitru seeks to understand why certain forms of mobility, particularly cross-border mobility, have been politically prohibited or permitted. She was principal investigator for research projects in "Migration and human development" and "Political theory of migration and methodological nationalism".

Speranta Dumitru has published numerous articles on gender, migration, equal opportunity, and global justice in scientific journals such as *Migration Studies*, *Ethical Perspectives*, *Ethnic and Racial Studies*, *Women's Studies International Forum*. She is currently working on a book on freedom of movement.
